July 26

It's the birthday of Irish playwright George Bernard Shaw, born in Dublin in 1856. He's the author of dozens of plays, including *Man and Superman* (1905), *Pygmalion* (1912), and *Saint Joan* (1923). Shaw won the Nobel Prize in literature in 1925 and an Oscar in 1938 for his film *Pygmalion*. He's the only person in history to receive both the Nobel and an Oscar.
